## **OBJECTIVES OF THE PRACTICE:**

New students must be introduced to the college's procedures and surroundings at the start of the academic year. Therefore, Rajkiya Mahavidyalaya Bazpur hosts an orientation workshop for incoming students each year. The framework of the student orientation course is comprised of three basic purposes.

- Introducing students to their college life
- > Incorporating students in the college environment.
- Giving the opportunity to the faculties to get connected to the new students.

#### THE CONTEXT

Work conditions differ across secondary schools and higher education institutions. Understanding numerous committees, cells, departments, and college faculties' functioning and responsibilities may be challenging for new students. After realising the difficulties that new students of the college experience, IQAC designed a student orientation programme. On August 8, 2019, the very first orientation programme was held. Because of the COVID Pandemic, the second orientation course was held online. Owing to the pandemic's prohibitions on gathering, the third orientation programme too was held online.

The purpose of this programme is to better acquaint our new students with the academic and administrative framework of the college. This effort seeks to close the knowledge gap between the educational system and the college environment by educating students about the numerous facilities, fellowships, courses, and activities that colleges have to offer.

#### THE PROGRAMME:

The structure and topics of the orientation programme was decided by IQAC in collaboration with the relevant departments and committees. This was a one-day programme. The principal addressed the incoming students before the first of three sessions and the organising secretary offers a vote of appreciation. Speakers were asked to keep their talk brief and to the point.

As the aim of the programme is to introduce new students to the college's environment. students are informed about the college's brief history, achievements, values, vision, future plans, teachers and departments. Students are also be introduced to the extracurricular activities, events, and facilities the college offers.

The programme was divided in to three sessions one inaugural and introductory session followed by to technical sessions.

## First Session: Inauguration and Introduction of College Faculty

This session is an crucial elements of the programme. The faculty members were introduced to new students at this session. Students were informed of the credentials in teaching and research as well as the significant accomplishments of the teachers.
