Background:

The transition from academics to a professional career is a critical phase in a student's life. Recognizing this need, the Career Counselling Cell of Government P.G. College, Bazpur, organized a Career Counselling Programme on 30th September 2024 to guide students in making better career choices and preparing for competitive exams. Technical Session:

Key Highlights of Dr. A.K. Singh's Lecture:

Government Job Opportunities:

Dr. Singh began by explaining the various sectors within the government that offer rewarding career opportunities. He highlighted that government jobs provide stability, attractive benefits, and the chance to contribute to the nation's development.

Dr. Singh emphasized that GK and GS are the foundation of civil services preparation. He detailed the important areas of focus, including:

History and Polity: Indian history, the Constitution, political systems, and governance.

Economics: Economic policies, development programs, and current economic challenges.

Geography: Both physical geography and human geography of India and the world.

He advised students to stay updated on national and international events, government schemes, and significant global developments, as these are frequently tested in the exam.

Dr. Singh shared a practical study plan for students, emphasizing the importance of regular reading, taking notes, and practicing with previous years' question papers. He also suggested using mock tests as an essential tool for self-evaluation.

He encouraged students to maintain a disciplined study routine, with a balance between reading textbooks, current affairs, and revising key concepts. He mentioned that mastering time management is key to covering the vast syllabus.

One of the major highlights of his lecture was the announcement of free General Knowledge (GK) and General Studies (GS) classes for the students of the college. These classes will focus on preparing students for competitive exams by covering core areas in GK and GS, along with providing exam tips and solving past papers. The initiative was received with great enthusiasm by the students, as it offered them a valuable resource to enhance their preparation for government exams.

Dr. Singh also emphasized the importance of answer writing skills for the Mains exam. He advised students to practice writing structured and wellargued answers within the time limits of the exam. Additionally, he shared tips on selecting the right optional subject for the Mains, encouraging students to choose subjects they are passionate about and have a good understanding of.

The event concluded with Dr. Atul Upreti delivering a vote of thanks. He expressed his gratitude to the Principal of Government P.G. College, Bazpur, for granting the necessary permission to organize the event. 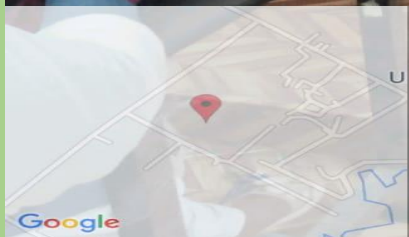

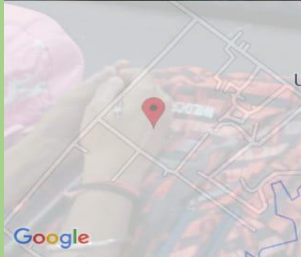

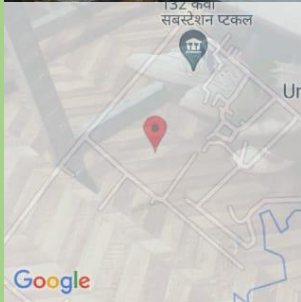
