By fostering entrepreneurship, the program contributes to increased employment and self-employment rates, promoting innovation and problem-solving skills essential for navigating the challenges of starting and running a business. As participants launch their enterprises, they not only enhance their own livelihoods but also contribute to community development by generating employment opportunities and stimulating local economies.

Implemented by the Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDII), this program targets students, youth seeking livelihood opportunities, and marginalized communities, including differently-abled individuals. The primary objective of DUY is to provide comprehensive entrepreneurial skill development and training, enabling participants to become self-reliant and successful entrepreneurs. The scheme offers free-of-cost training in various aspects of entrepreneurship, including business planning, financial literacy, operations management, and marketing strategies. It also includes support mechanisms such as boot camp pitching events and seed funding opportunities for aspiring entrepreneurs.

Day 1: March 30, 2024 (Saturday) - Introduction to Entrepreneurship

The program commenced with an introduction to the concept of entrepreneurship. Participants engaged in discussions about the importance of entrepreneurship in economic development and the traits of successful entrepreneurs. Ice-breaking activities facilitated networking among participants.

Day 2: April 1, 2024 (Monday) - Business Idea Generation

Focus shifted to brainstorming and generating viable business ideas. Participants were guided through techniques for identifying market gaps and assessing their ideas' feasibility through group exercises and individual reflections.

Day 3: April 2, 2024 (Tuesday) - Market Research Techniques

Participants learned about conducting effective market research. Sessions included methods for gathering customer insights and validating business ideas, culminating in practical exercises where participants designed their own surveys.

Day 4: April 3, 2024 (Wednesday) - Business Planning Essentials

The day was dedicated to understanding the components of a robust business plan. Participants worked on creating outlines for their plans and received feedback from mentors on financial projections and operational strategies.

Day 5: April 4, 2024 (Thursday) - Developing a Business Model

Using the Business Model Canvas, attendees explored different aspects of their business models, including value propositions and customer segments. Group activities encouraged collaboration and sharing of ideas.

Day 6: April 5, 2024 (Friday) - Legal Framework for Startups

This session covered the legal aspects of starting a business, including registration processes, types of business entities, and compliance with local regulations. Experts provided insights into intellectual property rights relevant to entrepreneurs.

Day 7: April 8, 2024 (Monday) - Financial Management Fundamentals

Participants delved into financial management principles, focusing on budgeting, cash flow management, and funding options available for startups. Practical exercises helped solidify understanding of financial statements.

Day 8: April 9, 2024 (Tuesday) - Marketing Strategies for Entrepreneurs

The focus was on developing effective marketing strategies. Participants learned about digital marketing tools, branding techniques, and customer engagement strategies through interactive workshops.

Day 9: April 10, 2024 (Wednesday) - Industrial visit and Operations Management Insights

On day 9 participants of the Entrepreneurship Development Program (EDP) visited Varun Beverages in Bazpur, where they gained insights into the beverage manufacturing process. The plant management welcomed them and provided an overview of the company's history and its partnership with PepsiCo. During the tour, participants observed production stages, including raw material procurement, bottling, and packaging, while learning about advanced machinery and quality control measures. The plant manager also discussed sustainability practices, emphasizing waste management. This hands-on experience allowed participants to engage directly with industry professionals and deepen their understanding of operational challenges in the beverage sector. This day covered the essentials of operations management, including supply chain logistics and quality control measures. Case studies illustrated successful operational strategies from established businesses.

Day 10: April 11, 2024 (Thursday) - Networking Skills Development

Participants engaged in networking activities designed to enhance their professional connections. Discussions emphasized the importance of building relationships in the entrepreneurial ecosystem.

Day 11: April 12, 2024 (Friday) - Pitching Techniques Workshop

The penultimate day focused on crafting compelling business pitches. Participants practiced their pitches in front of peers and received constructive feedback from experienced entrepreneurs.

Day 12: April 13, 2024 (Saturday) - Program Wrap-Up and Future Planning

The final day involved reviewing key learnings from the program and creating actionable plans for launching their businesses. Networking opportunities were provided to connect with mentors and fellow participants for future collaboration.

The EDP organized by EDII and Government P.G. College successfully equipped participants with essential entrepreneurial skills while fostering a vibrant entrepreneurial spirit in Bazpur.
